******* Notes For Exhibitors *******

Help is needed to set up the show from 1 pm on Saturday 11th March and to dismantle the show on Sunday 12th March after the show is closed. Workers names will automatically go into the draw for prizes on Sunday after the show has been dismantled.

Cages and litter will be supplied by the club. Those wishing to use larger Cages are to advise this on their entry form. **Limited large club cages are available. Please indicate if you have your own or need one from the club. Own cages MUST be at the show venue by 2pm on set-up day (Saturday 10th).**

Standard club cages for adults are 21/22in and kittens 18in. Bedding must be provided for each exhibit. Coloured bedding and/or curtains may be used.

You may provide a white towel on the top of your cage for judging. Please note that some judges will not use the towels, and this is at the judges' discretion.

Please provide a litter tray for your exhibits (small plastic container the size of a shoe box is ideal). Litter will be provided by the club.

All exhibits must be groomed, free from parasites and have their claws clipped
PLEASE NOTE THAT FAILURE TO CLIP CLAWS MAY RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION

The age restriction for showing or displaying kittens is 4 calendar months
ALL kittens must hold a current vaccination certificate with the most recent vaccination being dated at least seven (7) days prior to the show.

Please ensure you have your current vaccination certificate with you.

A Veterinarian will examine all exhibits in their cages after Benching. Please wait until the vet has cleared your exhibit before leaving the Show Hall. The vet clearance will be clearly marked on your exhibits cage card – only exhibits cleared may remain in the Show Hall.

Supreme Awards are calculated as follows:

10 points for BIS; 9 points for R/U BIS etc. Eligible exhibits MUST have won at least one BIS. Supreme exhibits will be decided by a judge's panel of one or more judges, between the Top points scoring LH Entire cat, kitten, N/S cat, kitten (supreme LH); Top points scoring SH Entire cat, kitten, N/S cat, kitten (supreme SH); Top points scoring LH Dom, SH Dom, LH Com, SH Com (supreme Dom/Com).

All Supreme winners MUST be photographed.

Please note that there may be club photographers present who may take photographs of you and/or your exhibits during the show. Entering the show constitutes acceptance that these photographs may be used by the club.

"For Sale" notices are NOT allowed on cages at any time.

Promotional material may be placed on the cages after all Judging is completed.
