DEFINITION OF TERMS USED

CAT: Feline of 9 months of age or older on show day

KITTEN: Feline under 9 months old on show day

JUNIOR CAT: Feline under the age of two years on show day INTERMEDIATE CAT: Feline 2 years old but under the age of 5 years SENIOR CAT: Cat 5 years but under the age of 7 on show day VETERAN CAT: Cat 7 years and older on the day of the show

KITTEN 4-6 MONTHS: Kitten 4 months but under 6 months on the day of the show KITTEN 6-9 MONTHS: Kitten 6 months but under 9 months on the day of the show

NZ BRED: Cat or kitten, neuter or spay born in New Zealand

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR BOTH SHOWS

SUPREME AWARDS: Geyserland Cat Club uses a computer-generated, scientifically calculated, points system in order to calculate the Supreme Longhair, Shorthair, Companion and Domestic. The overall supreme is then calculated on which of the above has the most points.

PLEASE NOTE: By-Laws for Exhibitors 4.3 (a)(i) "Any registered cat exhibited at a show held pursuant to these Show Bylaws shall be entered in the show in the name of the breeder or the person or persons to whom it has been transferred or leased, prior to the date of the show, as exhibitor".

PLEASE NOTE: Show By-Law 5.6(g) states: all kittens exhibited at ALL shows held under the auspices of the NZCF MUST show a current vaccination certificate with the most recent vaccination being dated at least 7 (seven) days prior to the show date.

- Coloured curtains and bedding is allowed in cages before and during judging. Plain white towels on top of cages is acceptable for judging purposes.
- Show ByLaw 5.6(e). All domestic cats and kittens and Companion cats and kittens show at NZCF Cat shows shall be desexed.
- Cat litter will be provided by the club. Litter trays to be provided by exhibitors.
- Exhibitors may place plastic covers on cage doors before the start of judging. These must be fixed to the door itself, not to the cage.
- Please ensure that your exhibit is in its *correct cage*. Failure to comply will result in your exhibit not being judged.
- Cage advertising: The Show Manager reserves the right to refuse or remove any advertising material on or in show cages on show day.
- No person has permission to sell cats or kittens on the day of the show, within the confines of the hall.
- **Veterinarian inspection**: Honorary vets will be in attendance. In-cage vetting will be done. Exhibits should be caged on arrival and Exhibitors are asked to extend every assistance to the examining veterinarians.
- All exhibits must have CLEAN EARS and COATS FREE FROM RINGWORM AND VERMIN.
 Owners of cats rejected will be notified in writing.
- Please note that any decision taken by the examining veterinary surgeons at this show is final.
- Exhibitors are required to stay within the show confines while vets are examining exhibits, or until advised by the Show Manager that you may leave. Any breach of this regulation will result in the disqualification of exhibits. Any Certificate of Clearance with respect to any disease, previously suffered by any animal (whether exhibited or not) owned, or residing at the Exhibitors cattery, and issued by his or her own vet, should be available if any doubt or objection by any other Exhibitors should arise. Vaccination certificates (over 14 days old) to be presented on request.
- Please note: Any exhibit which has been exposed to or has suffered from an infectious or contagious illness within a period of 21 days prior to this show is **not** allowed to be benched, and NO CAT OR KITTEN shall be exhibited if the Exhibitor has had any such illness in his/her cattery during this period. Exhibits must be brought to the show in carrying boxes or cages, not on leashes or carried in exhibitors arms. Carrying cages can be stored under the cat's show cage. Identifying names must be covered before judging.
- It is also a requirement that all entries should have their claws clipped. Please ensure that you comply with this request.

- This club will be most anxious for the care and safety of the cats and kittens brought or sent for exhibition and any other property entrusted to it, but it must be strictly understood by all exhibitors and all other persons that this club will not accept responsibility for the loss, damage or detention of any exhibit or any property, whether arising from accident or other cause, by its officers, agents or any other person. No exhibit will be permitted into the hall after 8.15am except at the discretion of the Show Manager.
- Catering: Early morning tea is available to all exhibitors. Morning Tea and Lunch will be provided for all official helpers. A light lunch and snacks will be available at a reasonable cost.
- Assistance before the show: We would appreciate assistance in setting up our show on the day before. MANY HANDS MAKE LIGHT WORK. If you are able to help either during the day or after work please let the Show Manager know.
- Assistance during the show: We would appreciate assistance on show day. We would like to
 give preference for "Handlers" to those who are new breeders or new to showing cats. We also
 need scribes, stewards, etc. If you can help in any way please indicate on your entry form.
- Any <u>certified</u> Stewards or Handlers who are available to assist are requested to contact the Show Secretary prior to the show.
- Assistance after the show: Every club has a problem cleaning up after the show. If everyone stayed back for 15 minutes to help clean up and pull the show down there wouldn't be a problem. We would greatly appreciate your help in the following tasks:
 - 1. Until and pull out the ropes that hold the cages down to the trestles.
 - 2. Remove all pins from the cage, or if it has ties then undo these.
 - 3. Carefully wave the cage in the air until it folds down into a flat shape. Please don't force it where it won't go ... it will go another way.
 - 4. Take said cage to the appropriate door (Show Manager will indicate) and stack so when the truck comes it will all be ready.

If you all help us that far then all that needs to be done is to sweep the hall and unload the truck at the other end. It's very social and a hive of activity pulling down a show and with enough hands it happens very quickly
