- 1. For Cat and Kitten of the Year, entrants must have been:
 - a] Best in Show, Reserve Best in Show, Best Opposite Sex in Show, at any show held under the rules of the NZCF over the period 15 July 2017 to 14 July 2018, both dates inclusive.
 - b] The 2017 Cat of the Year is entitled to defend its title at this show.
 - c] A kitten which qualifies in 1(a) above this show season, but reaches adult age prior to 14 July 2018 qualifies to enter in Kitten of the Year and also Cat of the Year if the criteria is met.
- 2. An exhibit, which has not previously qualified but achieves the approved status on 14 July 2018, will be considered for the appropriate award. The show secretary must be informed by the exhibitor of the intent to enter immediately and the fee paid, so the entry can be processed.

For entries that qualify prior to the show date, Nominees to be entered separately in the space provided on the entry form .
