## CAT, KITTEN & COMPANION OF THE YEAR

There is a charge of \$5.00 per exhibit to enter into the Cat, Kitten & Neuter/Spay of the year.

Criteria for entry:

1. For Cat and Kitten of the Year, entrants must have been:
  - a) Best in Show, Reserve Best in Show, Best Opposite Sex in Show, at any show held under the rules of the NZCF over the period 15 July 2017 to 14 July 2018, both dates inclusive.
  - b) The 2017 Cat of the Year is entitled to defend its title at this show.
  - c) A kitten which qualifies in 1(a) above this show season, but reaches adult age prior to 14 July 2018 qualifies to enter in Kitten of the Year and also Cat of the Year if the criteria is met.
2. An exhibit, which has not previously qualified but achieves the approved status on 14 July 2018, will be considered for the appropriate award. The show secretary must be informed by the exhibitor of the intent to enter immediately and the fee paid, so the entry can be processed.

**For entries that qualify prior to the show date, Nominees to be entered separately in the space provided on the entry form .**

**Breeders Award of Merit:** The NZCF Inc offers a Breeder's Award of Merit, one in each of the Entire Cat, Entire Kitten and combined N/S Cat/Kitten sections. This will be awarded at the discretion of the Judge who, in his/her opinion, is the most worthy of the award. The certificate will be forwarded to the breeder of the exhibit. No class and no entry fee.

#### \*\*\*\*\*Notes for exhibitors\*\*\*\*\*

- **SET-UP – FRIDAY** – Our show cages are 22" square. We will be setting up on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> between 10-2pm.
- **Anyone with large cages MUST BE ON SITE BEFORE MID-DAY – NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- Help is needed to set up the show on Friday from **10.00am** and also to dismantle the show after 5.00pm.
- The Club welcomes all offers of help – Handlers, Stewards - please put your offer on your Entry Form. Morning tea will be provided for all workers.
- Cages and litter will be supplied by the club.
- ALL cats entered in the Neuter/Spay, Domestic and Companion classes **MUST BE DESEXED.**
- Bedding must be provided for each exhibit. Coloured bedding and/or curtains may be used.
- **KITTENS:** ALL kittens must hold a current vaccination certificate **with the most recent vaccination being dated at least seven (7) days prior to the show. Please ensure you have your current vaccination certificate with you.**
- A Veterinarian will exhibit ALL exhibits in their cages after benching. Please wait until the Vet has cleared your exhibit before leaving the show hall. The vet clearance will be clearly marked on your exhibit's cage card – only exhibits cleared may remain in the show hall.
- **"For Sale" notices are NOT allowed on cages at all times.**
- **There will be NO catering at the show. Family Bakery in Prosser Street has excellent food (just up the road).**
- **Breakfast tea and toast will be available for \$2.00/head.**
