SCHEDULE OF CLASSES – COMPANION CATS & KITTENS and DOMESTIC CATS & KITTENS

All Domestic and Companions will be entered automatically into relevant classes.
 Exhibits will be automatically entered into side classes, e.g. Best Groomed, Eye Colour, Temperament.

Companion and Domestic Cat Coat Definitions

Longhair has a coat of **MORE** than 3 cm long (approx 1 inch) and stands out from its body when brushed forwards. Hair on tail may stand out like a plume.

Shorthair is not easily brushed forward, may be flat and sleek or dense but not flowing.

Companion and Domestic Cats Entry Eligibility

1. All Companion cats and kittens **must be desexed** (neutered or spayed)
2. All Domestic cats and kittens **must be desexed** (neutered or spayed)
3. All Kittens must hold a current vaccination certificate with the most recent vaccination being dated at least seven (7) days prior to the show. Please ensure you have your current vaccination certificate with you.
4. Exhibits entering the Companion Cats Section must meet the criteria of Rule 6a of the NZCF Registered Companion Cats Section

(6a – As this division is intended as a division to enable pedigree, part pedigree, or pedigree phenotype cats to be shown specifically separate from unregistered Domestic exhibits, no cat without prior dispensation from the Executive Council which has been awarded Grand Champion or higher in either Entire or Neuter/Spay Divisions will be permitted to be shown as Registered Companion Cats).

NZCF Award points to all top ten placings.

Breeders Award of Merit: The NZCF Inc offers a Breeder's Award of Merit, one in each of the Entire Cat, Entire Kitten, N/S Cat and N/S Kitten sections. This will be awarded at the discretion of the Judge who, in his/her opinion, is the most worthy of the award. The certificate will be forwarded to the breeder of the exhibit. No class and no entry fee.

To obtain title points and annual awards points, exhibitors must be an associate member of the NZCF. For details on becoming a member, please visit www.nzcf.com.

*****Notes for Exhibitors*****

- The committee reserves the right to limit or refuse entries without explanation.
- **SET-UP – FRIDAY** – Our show cages are 22" square. We will be setting up on Friday 16th between 10-2pm.
- **Anyone with large cages MUST BE ON SITE BETWEEN THESE TIMES – NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- Help is needed to set up the show on Friday from **10.00am** and also to dismantle the show after 5.00pm on Saturday.
- The Club welcomes all offers of help – Handlers, Stewards - please put your offer on your Entry Form.
- Cages and litter will be supplied by the club – cages are 22" square.
- Bedding must be provided for each exhibit. Coloured bedding and/or curtains may be used.
- A Veterinarian will check ALL EXHIBITS in their cages after benching. Please wait until the Vet has cleared your exhibit before leaving the show hall. The vet clearance will be clearly marked on your cage card – only exhibits cleared may remain in the show hall.
- **KITTENS:** ALL kittens must hold a current vaccination certificate **with the most recent vaccination being dated at least seven (7) days prior to the show. Please ensure you have your current vaccination certificate with you.**
- "For Sale" notices are **NOT** allowed on cages at all times.
