- All Domestic and Companion Cats must be desexed.
- Kitten vaccination certificates must be presented on entry to the venue.
- Please no distractions during judging such as ringing mobiles or flash photography.
- Exhibits must remain in the show hall until the end of the show. Early release requires written prior approval of the show manager see NZCF Show Bylaws para 10.8
- Only paper litter provided by the club may be used at the venue.

HELPERS ARE NEEDED:

As the number of Aby & Somali Club Members who are sane & able-bodied is reduced, we ask for assistance especially for the **set up at the venue on Friday from 4-6pm**, and at the close of the show. As the active members of the club are occupied running the show on the day, we rely on volunteers to work as stewards, handlers and scribes – please offer if you are able, even if for part of the day.

Exhibitor's free tea and coffee, breakfast offerings. Morning tea is provided for workers. Lunch is provided for the judges only. Afternoon cake cutting.

Size of show cage = 600mm wide, 440mm high, 420mm deep

General Rules & Conditions for All Exhibitors

- 1. This Show is held under the rules of the NZCF Inc and all exhibitors are deemed to have agreed to abide by these rules. A copy of the NZCF Show Rules and By-Laws can be downloaded from the website: www.nzcf.com
- 2. By Laws for Exhibitors 4.3 (a) (i): Any registered cat exhibited at a show held under these Rules & By-Laws shall be bred by the exhibitor in whose name it is entered or shall have been transferred to the exhibitor prior to the date of the show.
- 3. All exhibits must be brought to the show in carrying boxes or cages, not on leashes or carried in the arms. The carry cage is to be stored under the cat's show cage. The club provides the display cage at the venue unless otherwise requested prior to the show.
- 4. Cage Decorations are allowed for this show, but please keep in mind the practicalities of judging your cat and the ease of access for the judge. If you are not decorating your cage, supply your cat or kitten with a coloured towel or blanket to make the show colourful and fun. A container of water should be provided for exhibits.
- 5. Exhibitors are responsible for entering their cats in the correct classes; only those exhibits registered with the NZCF Inc are eligible to be entered in the registered section. Each cat shall be clearly identified on the entry form; such identification shall include; date of birth, Breed Number, Sire & Dam & Registration Number of the exhibit. If a cat is owned by more than one person, all owners must be listed.
- 6. Any exhibit which has been exposed to or has suffered from an infectious or contagious illness within a period of 21 days prior to this show is not allowed to be benched, and no cat or kitten shall be exhibited if the exhibitor has had any such illness in his or her cattery during this period.
- 7. All exhibits must be in good condition, have clean ears and be free from vermin or ringworm. They must not be declawed, but they **must have their claws clipped (front and back feet).**

8. NO EXHIBIT CAN BE BENCHED AFTER FINAL VETTING (8.45 am).

- 9. Vet Inspection as per By-Law 9c (ii) The Veterinary Surgeon's decision on the day shall be final and no discussion will be entered into. There are no refunds payable if a cat is rejected by the Veterinary Surgeon. Other exhibits entered in the show by the same exhibitor may be rejected also upon the advice of the Veterinary Surgeon.
- 10. Owners of a rejected cat will be notified in writing and the exhibit is to be removed from the show venue as soon as possible.
- 11. Exhibitors are requested to stay within the show confines while Vetting is conducted.
- 12. No exhibitor has permission to sell cats or kittens on the day of the show, within the confines of the venue. No advertising material (cattery cards, Kitten lists etc) may be exhibited on or in cages until judging is finished. The Club reserves the right to remove such material however The Club will provide an area for advertising
- 13. The refund of Entry Fees will be at the discretion of the Show Committee and only considered when a Certificate of illness, injury or death from a Veterinary Surgeon is received by the Show Secretary within 24 hours from the day of the show.
- 14. The Club accepts no responsibility for any loss or damage to any personal property, exhibits, boxes or carry cages, but will endeavour to see that all care is taken to prevent accident or injury to any exhibit.

15. No grooming is permitted in the show hall.

- 16. No exhibit is to be removed from the show venue before the close of show without the prior authorisation of the Show Manager. See NZCF Show Rule 10.8 and associated form
- 17. Assistance in taking down the show after the close is most appreciated and allows **all** participants to get home in a timely fashion.
- 18. Student Judges may be working at the show, so if you do not wish your exhibit to be handled by a Student Judge please indicate this on your entry form.
- 19. The venue is now a Category One Historic Place and has multiple users please respect everyone's space, including parking considerately and please note there is no smoking anywhere at the venue including the decks and carpark.
- 20. The Pedigree & Domestic Supreme Exhibits will be decided by whichever has the majority of each judge's personal selection of their top exhibit from those they awarded BIS. Where there is no clear majority, the Supreme will be determined by chance from a draw of the judge's choices.

Kitten A Feline of either gender less than 9 months on show day

Kitten 4-6 mths Born between 4 and 6 calendar months prior to show day

Kitten 6-9 mths Born between 6 and 9 calendar months prior to show day

Open A class in which ALL exhibits of the same age group compete without restriction or

qualification.

JuniorCat 9 months or over but less than 2 years old on show dayIntermediateCat 2 years or over but less than 5 years on show daySeniorCat 5 years or over but less than 7 years on show day.

Veteran Cat 7 years or over on show day.
