SHOW BYLAWS

This Show is held under the Rules of the New Zealand Cat Fancy Inc and the Burmese Cat Club of New Zealand Inc. By signing the entry form or submitting an entry by email or online, all exhibitors are deemed to have agreed to abide by such rules.

A copy of the New Zealand Cat Fancy Inc Show Rules and Bylaws is available to be downloaded from the NZCF website www.nzcf.com

This will be a four Ring Open Show with in-cage Vetting and Cage Judging. Club-appointed handlers will be used but owner-handlers may be permitted at the discretion of the judge.

For an exhibit to be eligible for any NZCF awards or titles, the owner must be a member of the NZCF.

NZCF Scoring

Entire Cats, Entire Kittens, Neuter / Spay Cats & Neuter / Spay Kittens.

Top 10

Top 10 awards will be made for Entire Cats, Entire Kittens, Neuter / Spay Cats, Neuter / Spay Kittens.

Breeders Award of Merit

A Breeders Award of Merit is offered by the NZCF Inc to the Breeder of the exhibit which, in the opinion of the Judge, is most worthy of the award. One Breeders Award of Merit will be offered in the Entire Cat section, the Entire Kitten section, the Neuter/Spay Cat section and the Neuter/Spay Kitten section.

Supreme Awards

The Longhair & Shorthair divisions will each be awarded a club Supreme. There will be no overall Supreme award. Supremes will be announced at prizegiving. In addition, Best Overall Burmese or Related Breed Exhibits will be awarded in each ring.

Method: All judges will pick their top cat from their Best in Show winners in each division, and these will be presented as their nominations for Supreme. If there is no clear winner, silent judging by the judges panel of the nominated exhibits from each division will decide the Supreme winners.

Club Trophies

There will be no club trophies awarded at this show.

Student Judges

Student Judges, handlers and stewards may be on the floor completing practical assignments. If you do not wish to have your exhibit/s included in a hands-on assignment, please notify the Show Secretary.

During Judging

No exhibit may be removed from the cage, other than by the Judge or appointed assistant or with the permission of the Show Manager.

Show Bylaw 10.9

No exhibit shall be removed from the Show venue before the scheduled closing time without prior permission of the Show Manager or Show Secretary. See form attached to this schedule which is to be used for this purpose.

Own Show Cages

A limited number of club cages are available for hire at \$5/cage. Out of town exhibitors will be given preference. The size of the club show cages is 61cm x 45cm x 53cm.

Please ensure to note on your entries whether you are supplying your own cage or whether you wish to hire one of our cages.

If you can supply your own cage, please also note on your entry form the cage dimensions.

Preferably cages should be on hand at the show venue for set up by 10am on SATURDAY 26th July.

If this is not possible, cages may be set up at benching and must be set up in the specified area so as to minimise noise and disturbance to other exhibits.

VACCINATION CERTIFICATES

Vaccination Certificates for all Kittens must be shown to the Tally Clerk before benching (or attached to your cat's profile in Cat Shows Online at or before close of entries). These should be at least 48hrs old and not more than six months old. Certificates for adult exhibits to be presented if requested.

GENERAL RULES, REGULATIONS AND INSTRUCTIONS

ALL KITTENS must be at least four (4) calendar months old on show day, and have had **at least two** vaccinations, 3-4 weeks apart with the last dose having been administered **at least 48 hours** before show day. (Must include cover for Feline Rhinotracheitis, Feline Calicivirus & Feline Panleukopaenia.). **Vaccination Certificates** must be produced before benching. Failure to produce a valid certificate will mean that your Exhibit is refused entry.

NO EXHIBITORS shall exhibit a cat/kitten which to their knowledge at the date of the show has been exposed to any infection or contagious illness within the period of twenty one (21) days or a period as specified by the NZCF Inc rules to the date of the show. No cat shall be exhibited if the exhibitor has had such illness in their cattery or household during that period. Any exhibitor, who in the opinion of the show committee, making a false declaration in respect of the above shall be liable to severe penalties under the powers of the National Executive of the NZCF Inc.

ALL EXHIBITS should be brought to the Show in cages and NOT in a blanket or on a lead. Exhibits are received at the Show only on condition that the Club should not be responsible for any loss or damage to cages etc. THE CLUB ACCEPTS NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR EXHIBITS BUT WILL ENDEAVOUR TO SEE THAT ALL CARE IS TAKEN.

ALL EXHIBITS must have clean ears, clipped claws (to prevent injury to handlers and judges) and coats free from ringworm, mange and fleas.

CAGES AND LITTER will be supplied by the Club.

CLEAN BEDDING in the cage for each exhibit's comfort is a requirement, (exhibits that do not meet this requirement may not be judged). An unmarked toilet box, drinking water (recommended in a container fixed to the door) may be included.

VETTING – At least one Veterinarian will be in attendance at the show and will examine each cat/kitten in its cage after benching. Exhibits may be lamped for ringworm. Please stay in sight of your cage/s in case the Vet has a query about your cat or kitten.

When your exhibit has been vetted, a coloured sticker will be placed on your exhibit's cage card. Only those exhibits cleared by the Vet may remain in the Show Hall. Any exhibit declared unfit for exhibition will receive a NZCF Veterinary Rejection Certificate and must be removed from the Hall immediately. The examining Veterinarian's written rejection is final. NO correspondence will be entered into.

No entry fees will be refunded for exhibits declared unfit by the examining Veterinarian/s on the day of the Show. If you have a Veterinary Certificate for any reason, present this to the Veterinarian and when your exhibit has been passed, you must then give the Veterinary Certificate to the Show Secretary.

In the event of unforeseeable illness before show day, where a certificate of illness from a Veterinarian is in the hands of the Show Secretary by 5:00 pm on the day prior to the Show, entry fees will be refunded less 25% for the bookwork involved.

Female cats which are obviously in kitten, or lactating, entire male cats or kittens without both testicles palpable beyond the stomach wall and cats or kittens which have been declawed or devoiced shall be disqualified by the Veterinarian/s, or a Judge and a Veterinary Rejection Certificate will be completed as in Bylaw 9.4.

CARRY CAGES must be stored underneath the show cages and any means of identification obscured prior to judging. This is to comply with Health and Safety precautions.

SALE OF KITTENS – No exhibitor has permission to sell cats or kittens on Show Day within the confines of the venue or car park. Information can be provided at the Show.

PRIVACY ACT – If you do not wish to have your name in the catalogue please specify on your entry form.

NZCF SHOW RULE 2.1 (c) – The Show Committee may decline to accept any entry or entries to the Show, without giving any reason for such decision, and may elect to accept any entry or entries arriving after the closing date stated.

NZCF SHOW RULE 2.1 (f) – The Club does not require the exhibit to be entered in any Open Class, nor to be judged by more than one Judge, as nominated on the entry form.

NZCF SHOW RULE 2.1A – The Show Committee may offer prizes as it decides, subject to the NZCF Show Bylaws, provided always that classes or prizes shall not be offered for progeny Sired by a specific cat, and free service from a stud cat shall not be offered as a prize.

NZCF SHOW RULE 2.1B – Once this Show Schedule has been issued, classes or prizes shall not be added to, except for sweepstakes; and exhibits may only be entered in the classes for breeds, as published in the official Schedule of Breed Codes.

NZCF SHOW RULE 3.4 (a) – Any registered cat exhibited at a show held pursuant to the Show Bylaws of the NZCF shall be entered in the Show in the name of its breeder or the person or persons to whom it has been transferred or leased, prior to the date of the Show, as exhibitor.

NZCF SHOW RULE 4.6 Upon written application to the Show Secretary, any exhibit may be withdrawn from any show with full fee refunds prior to the show entry closing date; and after that date with a possible forfeiture of part or all of the club entry fee, and all payment of the benching fees due to the NZCF.

NZCF SHOW RULE 10.8 – Removal of an exhibit before the show has been officially closed without the prior permission of the Show Manager or Show Secretary will result in the loss of all club awards and NZCF annual awards points and any title points. For planned early departures, permission should be sought as soon as possible, and a minimum of 24 hours before the start of the show, using the Permission for Early Departure from a Show form. Emergency early departures still require the permission of the Show Manager or Show Secretary which should be recorded on the Permission for Early Departure from a Show form, which can be downloaded [here](#).
