

DEFINITION OF TERMS USED

CAT:	Feline of 9 months of age or older on show day
KITTEN:	Feline under 9 months old on show day
JUNIOR CAT:	Feline under the age of two years on show day
INTERMEDIATE CAT:	Feline 2 years old but under the age of 5 years
SENIOR CAT:	Cat 5 years but under the age of 7 on show day
VETERAN CAT:	Cat 7 years and older on the day of the show
KITTEN 4-6 MONTHS:	Kitten 4 months but under 6 months on the day of the show
KITTEN 6-9 MONTHS:	Kitten 6 months but under 9 months on the day of the show
NZ BRED:	Cat or kitten, neuter or spay born in New Zealand

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

DURING JUDGING

No exhibit may be removed from the cage, other than by the judge or appointed assistant, or with the permission of the Show Manager.

SHOW BYLAW 10.9

No exhibit shall be removed from the show venue before the scheduled closing time without prior permission of the Show Manager or Show Secretary. See form attached to this schedule which is to be used for this purpose.

VACCINATION CERTIFICATES

As Per Show By Law 3.11:

All kittens being exhibited at all shows held under the auspices of the NZCF must show a current vaccination certificate with:

a. a minimum of two vaccinations, and

b. the most recent vaccination being at least 48 hours prior to the show.

CLAW TRIMMING

It is now a mandatory requirement that your cat or kitten's claws have been trimmed to prevent injury to judges and handlers. Please ensure that the claws have been trimmed within 24 hours of the show.

STUDENT JUDGES

Student judges, handlers and stewards may be on the floor completing practical assignments. If you do not wish to have your cats/kittens included in a hands- on assignment, please notify the entry clerk on your entry form.

SUPREME AWARDS

Geyserland Cat Club uses a computer-generated, , points calculated system, which is based on the top ten placings to calculate the Supreme Longhair, Shorthair, Companion & Domestic. The Overall Supreme is then calculated on which has the most points.

FOOD AVAILABLE OFF SITE

As we are close to many eateries and a supermarket, we are not having catering on site, so you ware welcome to purchase from those vendors.

PARKING FOR EXHIBITORS

Free parking is available within the show venue's carpark.

<u>CAGES</u>

A limited number of hire show cages are available at \$5/Cage on a first-in-first-served basis.

Exhibitors traveling by air will be given preference.

Please ensure to note on entry form whether you are supplying your own cage or if you wish to hire one of our cages.

If you are supplying your own cage, please also note the dimensions on your entry form. The onus is on the exhibitor to ensure the measurement is correct.

Best practice is for all cages to be at the venue for show set up, if this is not possible, it is the exhibitors responsibility to ensure cages being bought in show morning are set up and secured by 8am.

PLEASE NOTE: Geyserland does NOT have cage dividers, you will need to supply your own.

Permission for Early Departure from a Show
